

An integral part of what makes the Bookeye 4 *truly* a walk-up scanning solution is the integrated 19 inch preview screen, located at the center of the unit. Operators walk up to the device, scan a source document and receive instant image verification via the preview screen.



Utilizing the latest technology, the TFT monitor features energy saving and long lasting LED backlight illumination, with a life span of over 20,000 hours.

Bookeye 4's preview screen is ideally positioned directly in front of the operator, eliminating any awkward postures while scanning or uncomfortable overhead glare. For high volume scanning tasks, this is a more ergonomic solution than controlling image results displayed on a connected PC monitor, somewhere off to the side of the scanner.

Using job mode, users can scan multiple pages of documents and print them on a remote printer or save them as a multipage PDF file or JPEGs in a ZIP file to a connected USB device, SMB network drive or FTP server – all with a single press of a button.

The easily accessible (also operator-centered) touchscreen makes scanning even hundreds of pages of a book in a single session a snap. The Bookeye 4 is fully wheelchair accessible and [VPAT documentation](#) for the device is available.
